








Through Belgium, Germany, & Poland the ambulances & evacuation vehicles crossed the border into Ukraine on May 22nd, to begin their mission to help transport and heal the wounded.





Mission accomplished!

The official handover ceremony of ambulances and evacuation vehicles took place May 24th in Kyiv. These vital vehicles are destined for the Territorial Defense Forces in the Sumy and Kyiv regions of Ukraine, where they will play a crucial role in saving lives.

Medical professionals estimate that each ambulance can potentially save up to 250 lives per month, supporting both civilian and military personnel impacted by the ongoing war.





This is the **second consecutive year** that UCCA has joined Ukraine Focus in delivering life-saving ambulances to Ukraine.
